

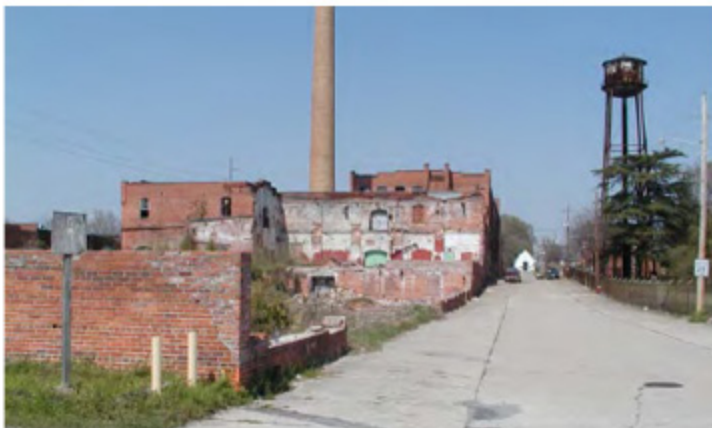

The City of Greenville, North Carolina, has received \$400,000 in grant funding from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency to conduct environmental site assessments at selected brownfields properties. Brownfields are vacant or underutilized properties where the risk of real or potential environmental contamination makes these sites unattractive investments for developers.
